INSTRUCTIONS TO FILL IN THE LIST OF PERSONS

Household members are the first to be entered into the list, followed by the temporarily present persons.

Household members are entered in the following order: the reference person first, followed by the members of his/her family (spouse/ partner in consensual union, and lastly children, if there are any).

If several families live in the household, the first to be entered are the members of the first family, followed by the members of the second family, etc.

Finally, the relatives and non-relatives considered to be household members are entered, and the temporarily present persons are the last to be listed.

Temporarily present persons are persons temporarily residing in the place of census due to work, school attendance, family, health or other reasons, and are residents of another settlement of the Republic of Croatia or a foreign country.
